R# 2 – 12 Mar to 20 Apr

R# 5 – 06 Aug to 14 Sept

R# 6 – 17 Sept to 26 Oct

- Your elective must have some semblance to medicine
- Your rotation should be six weeks in length, if you want to do a shorter rotation you will need to talk to Chris Wright
- Any non-Monash elective need to be approved by Chris wright (you will get more information about this at the Faculty lecture)
- Monash will provide you with any paperwork you might need but if your placement needs it sooner email: medstudentservices@monash.edu

Documentation normally required for non monash elective

- An academic reference/testimony/report from a member of staff at their home university/college who is familiar with their academic studies
- Official transcript from their university/institution listing the course and examinations they have taken to date
- Curriculum vitae (CV)
- Passport identification page
- Passport size photograph
- Police Check
- Application form/immunisation status
- **Fee**
- Student Visa

Monash electives

- In August preferences for medicine, surgery, ED, aged care, specialty will close there will be a week for 1-1 swaps
- Then the faculty will email saying Monash elective are open on blah date at blah time
- The left over rotations will be written on a spreadsheet and you send an email back with your preferences
- If you send it in the first minute you will usually get your first or second preference
